HISAKO HORIKAWA, JAPAN

Sardine and Hot wind Butch Dance

Choreographed and performed by Hisako Horikawa

Hisako Horikawa has been an assistant to Min Tanaka for many years. Together with him they won recognition as leaders in Butoh dance - a dance style, which originated in Japan during the 60's. It quickly became a world recognized performing practice, which tried to cross over the boundaries of the modern dance technique. Horikawa is co-founder of the world famous "Body Weather Laboratory" in Tokyo. In 1985 she started her solo dance series. She has performed in Japan, the USA and in Europe. In her performances Horikawa works on the borderline between Eastern and Western traditions in theatre composition. She has created a unique style of movement. Hisako Horikawa has conducted a number of workshops on the problems connected with "communication and body temperature of the performer". She has toured as guest solo dancer in opera performances throughout the world. In 1998 she was awarded the national prize "The New Face of Japan" - a special prize given to performers.




